## 1. Data controller and contact details

## 2. Object of the processing of personal data

Pursuant to art. 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 2016/679, we inform you the data collected are the following personal data: name, surname, email, company, telephone, city, profession and are necessary for:

- 2.1 Manage access to the reserved area of the site and its enabled contents.
- 2.2 In case of consent, for sending promotions and marketing activities organized by the Data Controller.

## 3. Purpose and legal basis of the processing

- **3.1** The personal data you provide will be processed exclusively for the purpose of managing what is indicated in points 2.1 and 2.2 and are subject to consent
- 3.2 The consent to point 2.1 is necessary in order to be able to perform the requested service

## 4. Recipients of personal data

4.1 The data will be communicated to us and may also be communicated to other companies, appointed as data processors, in carrying out the requested information service

#### 5. Mandatory nature of providing data

**5.1** Given that these data will be used exclusively for the direct purpose for which they are provided to us, failure to consent to the processing or failure to provide it in point 2.1 will not make it possible to supply the content in the reserved area of the site. Consent to point 2.2 is optional

#### 6. Rights of the interested party

- 6.1 Regulation (EU) 2016/679 recognizes the exercise of specific rights, including those to request:
  - confirmation as to whether or not your personal data is being processed and, in this case, to obtain access to it (right of access); the correction of inaccurate personal data or the integration of incomplete personal data (right of rectification); the deletion of the data, if one of the reasons provided for by the Regulation exists (right to be forgotten); the limitation of processing, when one of the hypotheses provided for by the Regulation occurs (right of limitation); to receive in a structured format, commonly used and readable by a computer device, the personal data you have provided and to transmit such data to another data controller (right to portability).

#### 6.2 How to exercise the rights

6.2.1 Requests can be sent to the references of the Data Controller, via email. At any time you can ask, without prejudice to what has been said above in relation to the lack of consent, to exercise your rights, including access to the personal data processed, the request to proceed with their rectification or cancellation, the limitation of treatment, as well as to revoke the consent provided or to oppose the processing itself, data portability, as well as to lodge a complaint with the Privacy Guarantor;

#### 6.3 Right to withdraw consent

- 6.3.1 With regard to the processing of data carried out on the basis of consent, you are entitled to withdraw the consent given at any time, without this affecting the lawfulness of the processing prior to the revocation.
- 6.3.2 The withdrawal of consent must be communicated in writing to the Data Controller who will issue a receipt.

#### 6.4 Right to lodge a complaint with an Authority

6.4.1 You are also recognized the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data, pursuant to art. 77 Reg., If you believe that the processing that concerns you violates the provisions of the EU Reg.

#### 7. Data retention

8.1 The data provided will be kept until the consent is revoked or the account is closed for point 2.1 and for 2 years in the case of consent for the purpose indicated in point 2.2.
